LGBTQ+ Art Show call for entries! Open to all LGBTQ+ residents of Humboldt County. This is a non-judged art show. All entries will be accepted until we run out of space. Participants entering the show must be living in Humboldt, LGBTQ+ and 18+. One entry per person. All entries must be ready to hang/display. Themes must be G to PG13. NO gore or nude photography (tasteful figure drawings/paintings okay), no sex/sexual acts (this is a kid friendly space), mild violence okay (avoid blood). Each artist is encouraged to type a short artist statement about their work and/or themselves (not a requirement). There is a \$1-\$5 suggested donation. No one will be turned away due to lack of funds. Types of medium accepted: Performance art (ex: musicians, poetry reciting, dance, aerial,drag etc.), poetry (printed and framed), drawings, paintings, sculpture, multimedia, crafts, photography, costumes. Entry forms must be filled out and submitted with your piece (cos-players, drag performers, fur suiters, musicians can submit a photo or description/song title with entry form. Musicians & Performers: you are responsible for sound setup. Synapsis has limited sound equipment.

Show theme: Open/no theme.

****All entries due by 5pm on May 31st****

Artists can take their work home after the opening celebration (contact Curator) or keep their work on display until June 29th. Participating artists will be part of a prize raffle.

- Because Synapsis is an all ages space, please keep themes PG13.

- One entry per person. All entries will be accepted until we run out of space. Keep subject matter PG13: no nudes (except things like tasteful figure drawings/paintings), NO sex or gore. Mild violence okay(Synapsis is an all ages venue).

- Costumes, drag and co-splay, performance art, and poetry count (this is a fur suit friendly event and your suit can be counted as an entry if it is your original character design/you made your suit). Performers and those wanting to recite poetry will be given a 15-30min slot (this means 6 guaranteed slots for performers. You can submit poetry without reciting by submitting a typed and framed copy. You can show up in fur suit, drag and co-splay entry without performing).

- Entry forms must be filled out and submitted with your piece (cos-players, drag performers, fursuiters, musicians can submit a photo or description/song title with entry form. You MUST drop off a form to enter into the show.

Musicians: you are responsible for sound setup, Synapsis has limited sound equipment. Please show up to the drop off days so you can be added to the set list.

Drag Performers: Please bring a device (like an iPod etc.) with the song you want played or send the file to drakenmunson@gmail.com with our name in the email by the day before the opening event. Please show up to the drop off days so your name can be added to the set list.

- There will be a raffle for artists this year, tickets will be on the entry form.

- **You will be able to drop off your work three days before the show.**

- **Suggested donation of \$1-\$5. You will not be turned away due to lack of funds. Donations help Synapsis and help with the cost of putting on the show.**
